

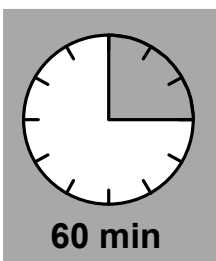

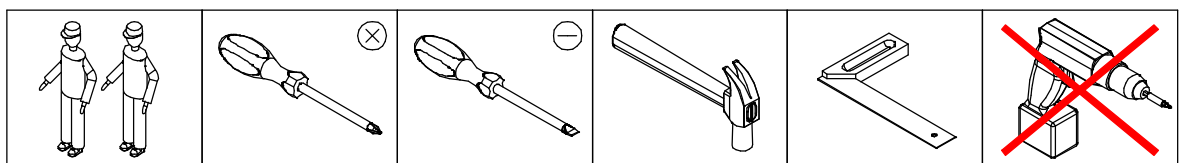

# Instructions for use

**IMPORTANT, READ CAREFULLY- RETAIN FOR FUTURE REFERENCE**

**WARNING:** This product is suitable for children above the age of 3 years old

## Before starting assembly:

\*Do not use this item if any structural part is broken or missing.

\*Check you have all the components and tools listed.

\*Remove all fittings from the plastic bags and separate them into their groups.

\*Keep children and animals from the work area, small parts could choke if swallowed.

\*Make sure you have enough space to lay out the parts before starting.

\*Assemble the items as close to its final position (in the same room) as possible.

\*Assemble on the soft level surface to avoid damaging the unit or your floor.

\*This furniture meets the european standard certification BS 4875-7:2006, FRQG C001:2008 & FRQG C004:2008



We do not recommend the use of power drills/drivers for inserting screws, as this could damage the unit. Only use hand screwdrivers.

\*Dispose of all packaging carefully and responsibly.

\*Assembly should be carried out by competent adult only.

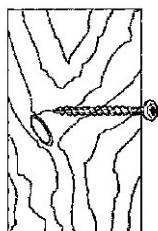
## Care and maintenance:

\* Only clean using a damp cloth and mild detergent, do not use bleach or abrasive cleaners.

\*Regularly check all fastenings to ensure that they properly tightened.

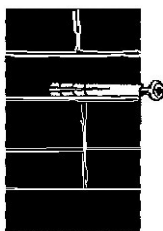
\*Our furniture will endure most temperatures in the home but it is best to avoid placing furniture next to the heat sources such as radiators or fires. Be particularly careful with solid wood as the lack of humidity caused by central heating can cause damage such as warping.

### Wall Fixing (if required)



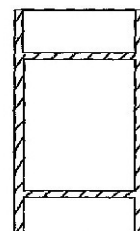
Wood

Use an appropriate wall plug provided you are sure your wall is sound.


















