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
Tips before you start!

- 1. Please check that all parts are present before you start the assembly of your furniture.
- 2. For ease and speed of assembly, we recommend that before you commence each step of the assembly, that you identify all the parts required for that step.
- 3. For larger items, please ensure that you have sufficient space and people (as indicated on page 1) to assemble your product safely. (Minimum Two Persons)
- 4. We recommend where possible, all items are assembled near to the area where they will be used, to avoid moving the product unnecessarily once assembled.
- 5. Please ensure that your bed is placed on a level floor area. (Avoid setting up and installing your bed on uneven floor surface)
- 6. For the protection of your furniture, we recommend that the product is placed on a protected surface during assembly to prevent any damage.
- 7. During assembly please take care not to over-tighten any fittings, as this may damage the product.


Care and Maintenance of your Furniture

- Please periodically check all fittings and re-tighten as necessary.
- To clean your item, please use a soft damp cloth and wipe clean.
- Please do not jump on your furniture.
- Never allow any kind of liquid to remain on your furniture. This can cause finishes to de-laminate.
 Take care when spraying Perfume and deodorants etc as the vapour can settle on the surface and cause damage.
- Periodically check the condition of your bed slats to ensure they are in good condition and have not become loose.
- It is important to never drag your bed as this can cause damage to the joints and the fixings. This may invalidate your guarantee.
- The bed should always be <u>lifted</u> into position or if moved for cleaning. Do not attempt to drag the bed across the floor.
- Periodically check the central support legs are perfectly upright and supporting the centre rail.

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




• Attach headboard legs using the fixings as shown.


- With help, carefully turn the headboard over.

- Insert fixings (N) and (U) as shown, but leave loose.






• Slide the side rail bracket over the inserted screw in the headboard and foot end as shown.








• Attach the cross stretcher as shown taking extra care to ensure the arrows are pointing upwards as shown.




